

Steps to become Waterfowl Hunter:

- 1.) Become a Regular Member (see steps for regular membership).
- 2.) After becoming a Regular Member (first year), you will receive a letter from the Membership Secretary in August inquiring if you are interested in waterfowl hunting / membership at Pleasant Hill. If you have previously upgraded to Regular Member, you will not receive this letter.
- 3.) Submit a letter to the Snye Committee / Duck Chairman indicating that you are interested in upgrading to Waterfowl Member and waterfowl hunting at Pleasant Hill.
- 4.) The Snye Committee recommends a Waterfowl Member quota yearly and the board sets the quota. The Snye Committee then will determine if and how many new waterfowl hunters will be accepted that year.
- 5.) You will be notified in August / September if your request to become a waterfowl hunter was accepted.
- 6.) If you get accepted, you will need to upgrade your membership to "Waterfowl Member" status at that time.
- 7.) You will be required to pay the yearly pump fee set by the Snye Committee, pay the Pleasant Hill Maintenance Fee, pay the initial waterfowl buy in fee (first year waterfowl hunters only), and complete the required work days before hunting.

Waterfowl Membership as of 2017 – (\$450)

Pump fee as of 2017 – (\$200)

Pleasant Hill maintenance fee as of 2017 – (\$240)

Initial waterfowl buy-in fee as of 2017 – (\$200)
