have some Saturdays open if you are looking for a place to hold your event.

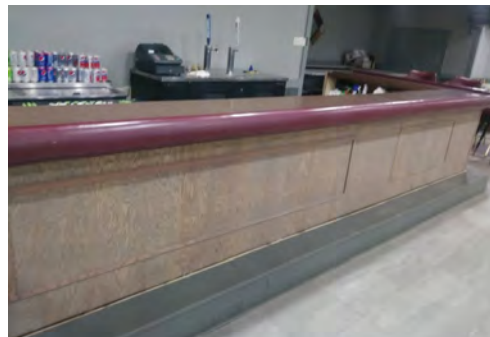
