

Alton Wood River Sportsmen`s Club Pleasant Hill Trailer Rules

1. Permanent trailer sites include Pad fee, cot fees for the trailer owner and spouse, electrical fees. Pad fees are **\$500.00** annually. This annual fee can be paid quarterly at **\$125.00** due March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31. There will be a late fee charge of **\$25.00** per month that will be assessed after the due date for up to 6 months. After 6 months the late fee will be **\$50.00** per month. Anyone in the arrears over 9 months will lose their permanent trailer site. All trailer pad fees must be paid in full, up to date before December 31^{rst} for the current year.
2. There are 2 temporary trailer sites. Temporary hookups are allowed for up to 15 consecutive days. Pad fees for temporary hookups are **\$15.00** per day per person for persons over 21 years of age and older.
3. Trailers will be required to be mobile at all times. (Mobile will be determined by the Sny Committee and trailer chairman).
4. No more than 2 trailers may be connected to an electrical box at any one time.
5. The trailer committee will contact all new trailer owners to see if they may want to change their pad location in the future. If so, their name will be added to the current "Move Up" list.
6. Members wanting to get on the "Waiting List" must submit a dated request via email to the trailer committee chairman. All trailer pads that are vacated will be filled by the following procedure.
 - A. When a trailer site becomes available, the trailer committee will announce via email openings for the "Move Up" list in the bulletin, Sny meeting, and Membership meeting.
 - B. Selection will be made by position on the trailer "Move Up" list first then the "Waiting list" will follow.
7. There will be no trading of trailer sites unless it is approved by the Sny committee and posted for 14 days by the Trailer chairman.
8. Major appliances such as Refrigerators are not allowed outside unoccupied trailers.
9. All registered trailer owners will put in 2 days of work at Pleasant Hill per year per trailer. Work to be done will be posted on the bulletin board by the grounds chairman and trailer chairman. Members may choose the work best suited to his or her abilities and capabilities. On completion of work day, he or she will sign his or her name on the

page of a book provided, with the date and work performed. Workdays must be completed by December 1. Failure to comply would be loss of trailer spot and go on the "Waiting List". This rule has nothing to do with duck and deer work required days.

10. All site improvements must be referred to the trailer committee. In addition, the trailer chairman has the authority to designate a trailer`s position on a trailer spot.

11. Storage of campers and unlicensed boats at Pleasant Hill is prohibited.
